Pet waste left on the ground carries disease causing bacteria, parasites, and viruses that can infect people who come in contact with it, particularly children and gardeners. Pet waste left on the ground can also contaminate our rivers and streams when it is flushed by rainfall into our storm drains and out to our waterways, making them unsafe for recreational activities such as fishing and swimming.

Picking up after your pet helps keep our waters clean and protects human health. After picking up the waste, dispose of it in a trash receptacle.
